## My Life, Understanding Death Tour

Not only the departed should rest in peace, but shouldn't the living also have to overcome their own struggles?

Having the opportunity to be in this world is already a gift, so why worry about when to get off? Cherish every moment, take in the scenery along the way, and enjoy this journey.

Most people understand that death is an inevitable process, but opinions vary when it comes to life and death. Some can face it with open-minded, while others consider death is a taboo.

What exactly is the meaning of life and death? What enlightening significance can bring to us by understanding life and death?

### Objectives

- Understand death, visit and interact with local funeral practices and arrangements.
- Broaden students' understanding of death, explain the significance of traditional rituals.
- Through experiential activities, guide students to reflect on the meaning of life and how to make life more fulfilling.
- Realize that being alive is a gift.
- Encourage students to cherish those around them and try to accept people with different views.
- Cultivate correct life values and learn to let go.

### Activities content

**A.M.** Funeral and burial site tour: Visit locations related to death such as cemeteries, coffin specialty shops.

**Noon** Return to Noah's Ark for lunch, followed by afternoon educational sessions.

**P.M.** Experiential learning activities: Allow students to experience the shock of death, guiding them to see life from the perspective of death, feel the joy in life, and learn to let go.

- Sharing to enhance self-understanding and escape from cognitive traps, developing inner abilities.
- Facing future adversities and challenges with perseverance and a positive attitude.

- Cultivating positive thoughts and attitudes.
- Learning effective communication and problems solving skills.
- Basic emotional management.
